












## (networked) Affect

- Affective networks
- Collective and individual victimization
- Everyday digital racism; Ambient racism

#### Nationalism

- Nativism; Ethnonationalism; Ethnocracy
- Palingenesis
- From securitization (of borders) to existential threats
- Femonationalism
  - Native (white) women's bodies as ideological "battleground"
- Everyday, banal & ambient expressions of inclusion/exclusion
