

About the Program

Undeclared Arts is for students who are still considering which major they want to pursue. Many students choose this first-year option to help them decide which direction they would like to go in their studies and later transfer into a major of their choice after completing their first year in Undeclared Arts.

Choose this first-year studies option to explore program areas in the social sciences and humanities. Discover your passion and strengths to help you select the program you wish to pursue as a major or double major. Students will have the opportunity to explore first year introductory courses across all Faculty of Arts disciplines.

Program Structure

Students will have the opportunity to explore first year introductory courses across all Faculty of Arts disciplines.

Students must complete two mandatory courses in first year that are essential in preparing students for university level learning.

In semester two, students will have the opportunity to complete one or two non-Arts electives in areas including film studies, business, child and youth care and more. Many of these interests can lead to a minor.

Typical First Year

Academic Writing and Research - SSH 205	Critical Thinking I - SSH 105
In addition to that you must choose 8 Electives (4 each semester) for your first year.	

Program Transfer

By February of the second semester, students must apply for program transfer to one of the programs listed below for second year. All completed courses will transfer to the new program.

How to Apply

Academic Requirements

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or equivalent with a minimum of six Grade 12 U or M courses including the following program specific requirements.

Typically, a minimum overall average of 70% establishes eligibility for admission consideration; subject to competition individual programs may require higher pre-requisite grades and/or higher overall averages:

- a minimum grade of 70% or higher will be required in Grade 12 U English/Anglais (ENG4U/EAE4U preferred).

Undeclared Arts welcomes applications from prospective students of all nationalities and gender identities, regardless of age, disability, race, religion, or sexual orientation.
