

Knowledge Mobilization Fund

Deadline / Continuous intake.

Purpose / The Faculty of Arts Knowledge Mobilization Grant supports the work of those aiming to use websites, blogs, podcasts, videos, infographics, and social media campaigns to translate research into accessible content for diverse audiences.

Eligibility / Faculty members for whom research related activities are part of their contractual obligations.

Amount / The Faculty of Arts Knowledge Mobilization Fund funds up to \$500.

Eligible Expenses /

- Creation of plain-language summaries, teaching modules.
- Expense related to media relations instruments (e.g., press releases, blogs, webinars, social media)
- Expenses related to photography, website creation/design, posters, audio-visual, videos, art.

NOTE: Funds cannot be awarded for past events/activities.

Review Process / The Dean and the Associate Dean of Research and Graduate Studies will adjudicate applications. Decisions are final and not subject to appeal.

Application / Please complete the [Google Form](#) using your TMU login and include documentation(s) as noted on the form.

Research Ethics / Successful applicants must receive approval from the TMU Research Ethics Board (REB) before conducting research involving humans, the use of animals, controlled goods, and hazardous materials. Successful applicants may request release of up to 50% of their award to conduct preliminary research. Please complete the [online release form](#). Completed and signed release forms should be sent to Alvin Ying (aying@torontomu.ca), Graduate Administration & SRC Coordinator and copied to Dr. Melanie Knight (melanie.knight@torontomu.ca), Interim Associate Dean, Research and Graduate Studies.

Responsibilities / Successful applicants will be required to submit a Final Research Report to the office of the Associate Dean of Research and Graduate Studies 3 months after the completion of the project or 27 months after the awarding of the grant, whichever comes first.

Acknowledgement / Successful applicants are required to acknowledge funding from the Faculty of Arts in all materials, presentations, and publications associated with the Knowledge Mobilization Grant with statements such as the following: “The preparation of this [book/article(s)/grant/ etc.] was supported with the Knowledge Mobilization Grant by the Office of the Dean of Arts.” Faculty members are reminded of their [Professional Development Allowance](#) that can be used for any special SRC project.
