Program Course Restrictions

- LIR students cannot use LIR 100 to meet their Required Group I, Table I requirements.
- Students who plan to declare the French stream cannot use FRE courses in Required Group I, Table I (only Core Elective, Table II); students who plan to declare the Spanish stream cannot use SPN courses in Required Group I, Table I (only Core Elective, Table II).
- First year students should not be selecting courses from Table A; Table A is taken in second year.

Important Information

- All course enrollment is done in RAMSS. Log in to my.ryerson.ca to access RAMSS, D2L Brightspace, and your Ryerson Gmail.
- First year LIR students should select and enroll in the **elective courses** shown above (3 in Fall, 4 in Winter).
- Verify that you are auto enrolled in your **required courses** shown above (2 in Fall, 1 in Winter), and alert your Program Administrator if you are not.
- Available Table I, Table II, and Open Elective (OE) courses can be found under "My Classes Offered" in RAMSS. As there are over 500 OE courses (divided by teaching faculty and alphabetically), students should focus their search on specific areas of interest.
- Required Group I, Table I courses are attached (space permitting).
- Please refer to the [Enrollment Videos](#) or the [RAMSS Support website](#) for instructions on how to add courses.
- Students should run an [Academic Advisement Report through RAMSS](#) to determine which courses they need to enroll in each semester, and to ensure that the courses apply to their program graduation requirements.
- Students are encouraged to use My Classes Offered and Visual Schedule Builder (VSB) to help create their optimal schedule.
- Classes are scheduled weekly as a three-hour lecture OR two-hour lecture and one-hour tutorial.
- Some courses have a wait list function. To add yourself to a wait list, please refer to the [Course Wait List website](#).
- A typical course load is 5 courses per semester. Students should speak to their Program Administrator if they wish to reduce course load.
- After you enroll in courses, check RAMSS for your timetable.
- Instructors will provide course outlines (including required texts) to students via D2L on the first day of classes.

Please consult with the Program Administrator for enrollment guidance. Note that LIR 100, 200, 300, 400 and 800 may only be taken in sequence (never concurrently), and only in the semesters indicated in the program curriculum in the [Undergraduate Calendar](#).
