Veronica Wilson is an immigration lawyer and the founder of Roots Immigration Law in Toronto, Ontario. She has extensive experience offering strategic legal advice and assistance to individuals, families and businesses in all areas of Canadian immigration law. Before opening her firm, Veronica worked at a boutique immigration law firm in Toronto, where she led the Canadian permanent residence practice.

Prior to completing her Juris Doctor at the University of Ottawa, Veronica taught English and lived in South Korea for several years. Her volunteer work with North Korean refugees and human rights advocates inspired her to pursue a career in immigration law with a focus on social justice and inclusivity.

Veronica is currently a pro-bono legal advisor to Talent Beyond Boundaries (TBB), a non-profit organization linking companies to international refugee talent and facilitating refugee relocation through economic immigration pathways. She has been the lawyer on file for early TBB candidates relocating to Canada and through this work has pioneered the emerging legal practice on access to Canada's economic programs for applicants in displacement.

She is currently an articling student at Roots Immigration Law. She is also on the board of the Junior Refugee and Immigration Lawyers Network.
