

PROGRAM TRANSFER APPLICATION MASTER'S TO DOCTORAL LEVEL

Section A: Overview

A student who wishes to transfer into a Doctoral program before completion of their Master's program at Toronto Metropolitan University, is required to:

- be enrolled in a Master's program at Toronto Metropolitan University
- have completed all of the course requirements for the Master's degree with a minimum A- (3.67) average
- have demonstrated research potential.
- sign the waiver below stating that they will not be eligible for the Master's degree if they do not complete the PhD.

Applications for a transfer must be submitted to the program director for approval before the first day of classes for the term in which the change is requested.

Section B: Application Procedure

- 1. Students must submit to their faculty advisor/supervisor.
 - a. this application form,
 - b. a copy of current unofficial academic transcript or academic history
 - c. a completed 4th Term Supervisory Committee Report for MSc Students Intending to Transfer to PhD
 - d. Reference letters from all members of the supervisory committee (to be submitted directly to the program office)
 - e. a letter providing detailed reasons for the application.
 - f. an updated CV including relevant research publications, presentations and research or academic awards.
 - g. a short summary (2-4 pages) of research progress achieved during the Master's program to date
 - h. a dissertation proposal title in abstract form (1-2 pages)

Note: The approval process may take longer if the application documents are incomplete.

- The Faculty Advisor/Supervisor will review the documents and recommend approval or disapproval (with comments) to the Program Director.
- 2. If approval is recommended by the Graduate Program Director, they will forward this application package and the transcript with **courses to be counted towards the PhD coursework requirement identified (See Section E)**, to the Vice-Provost and Dean.
- 3. The Vice-Provost and Dean will issue a written approval or disapproval to the student.

5. The vice-i lovost and bean will issue a written approval of disapproval to the student.
