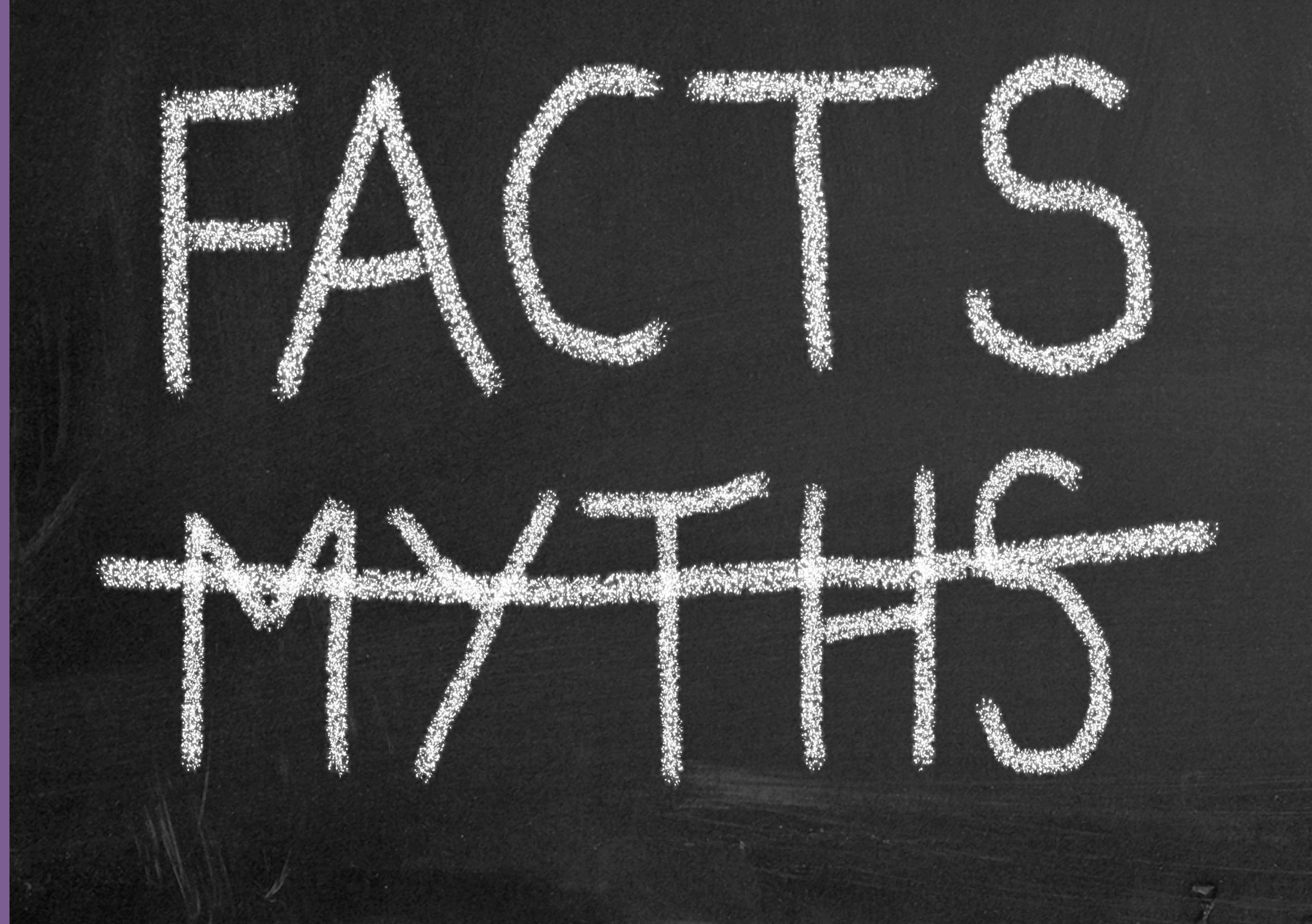


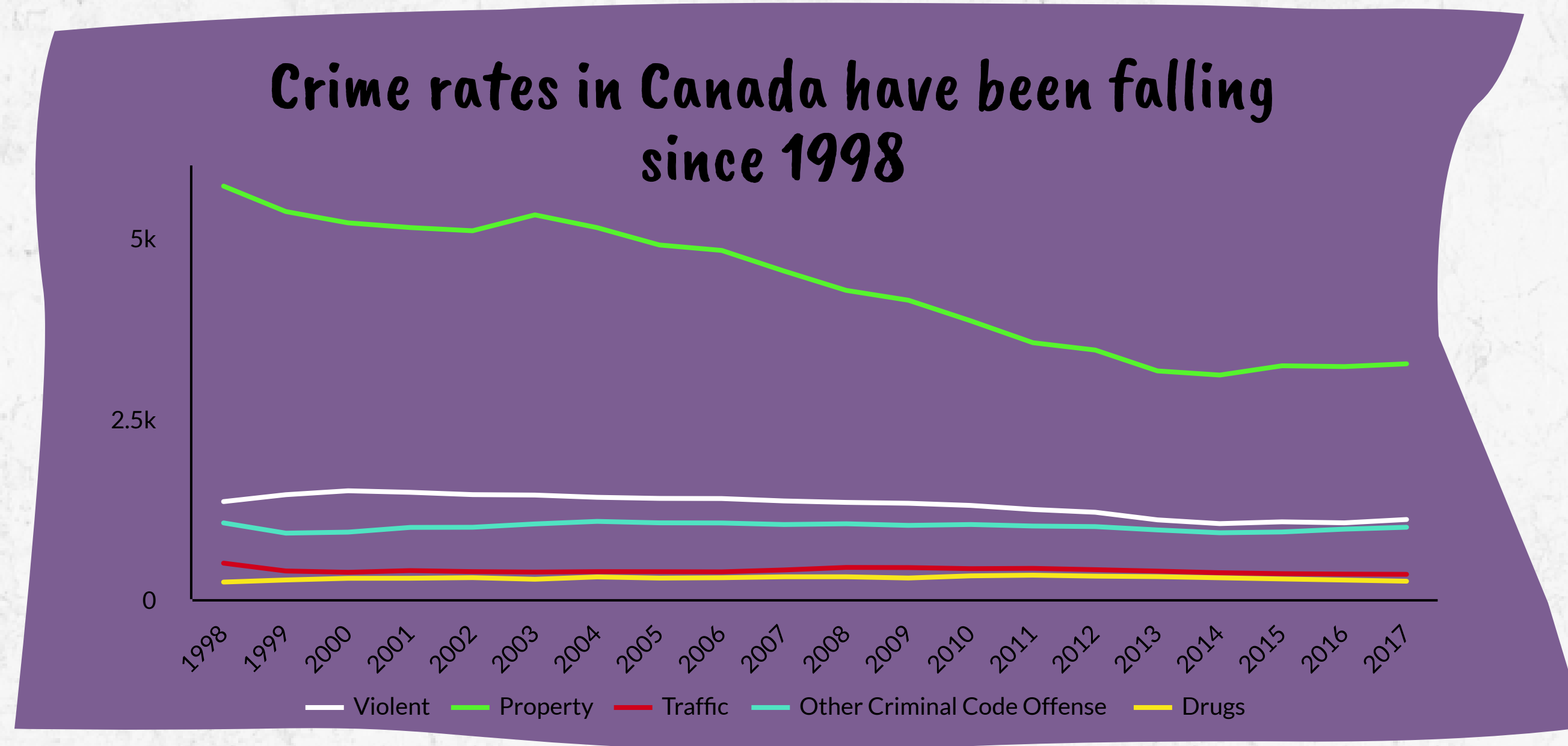

Crime today is worse than 10 years ago: myth or fact?

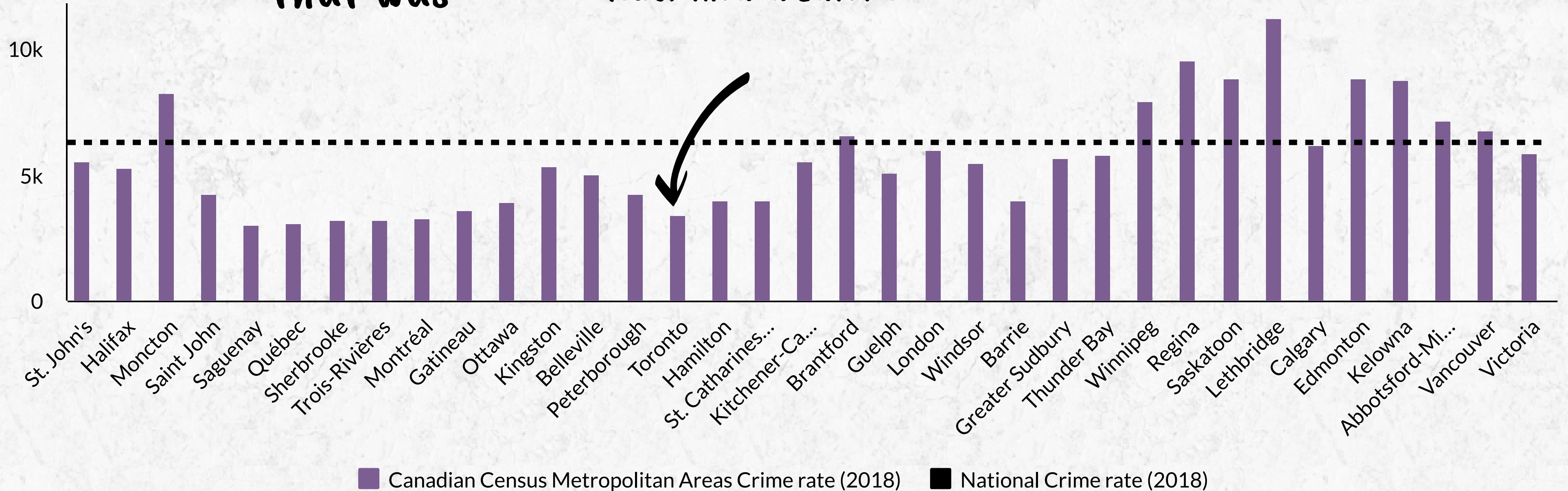


In 2018, Toronto police reported a crime rate that was

lower than in Ontario

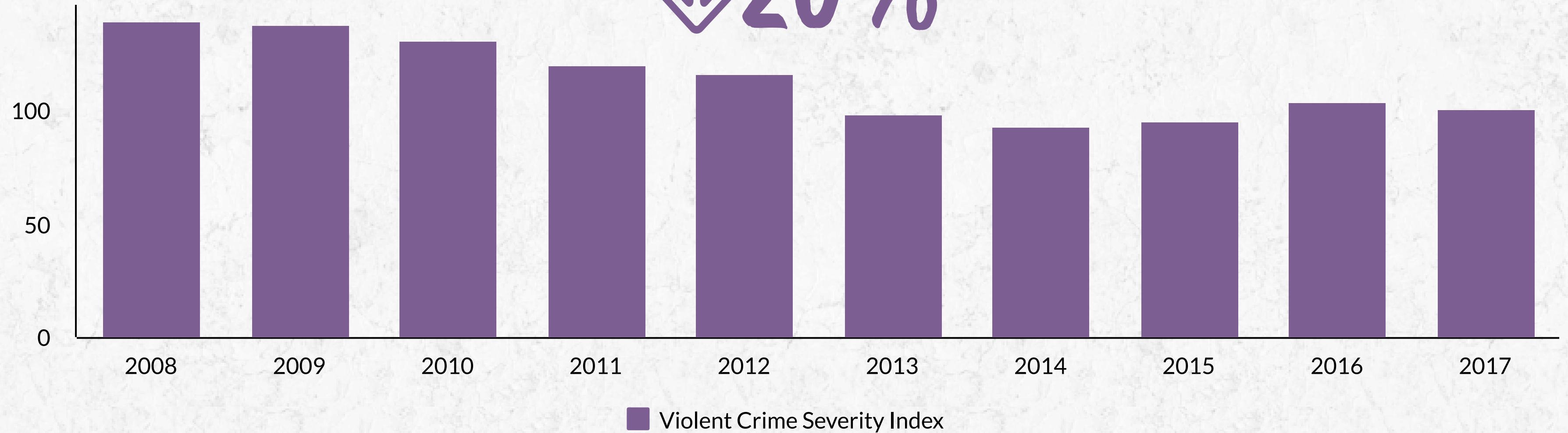
&

↓ 20%



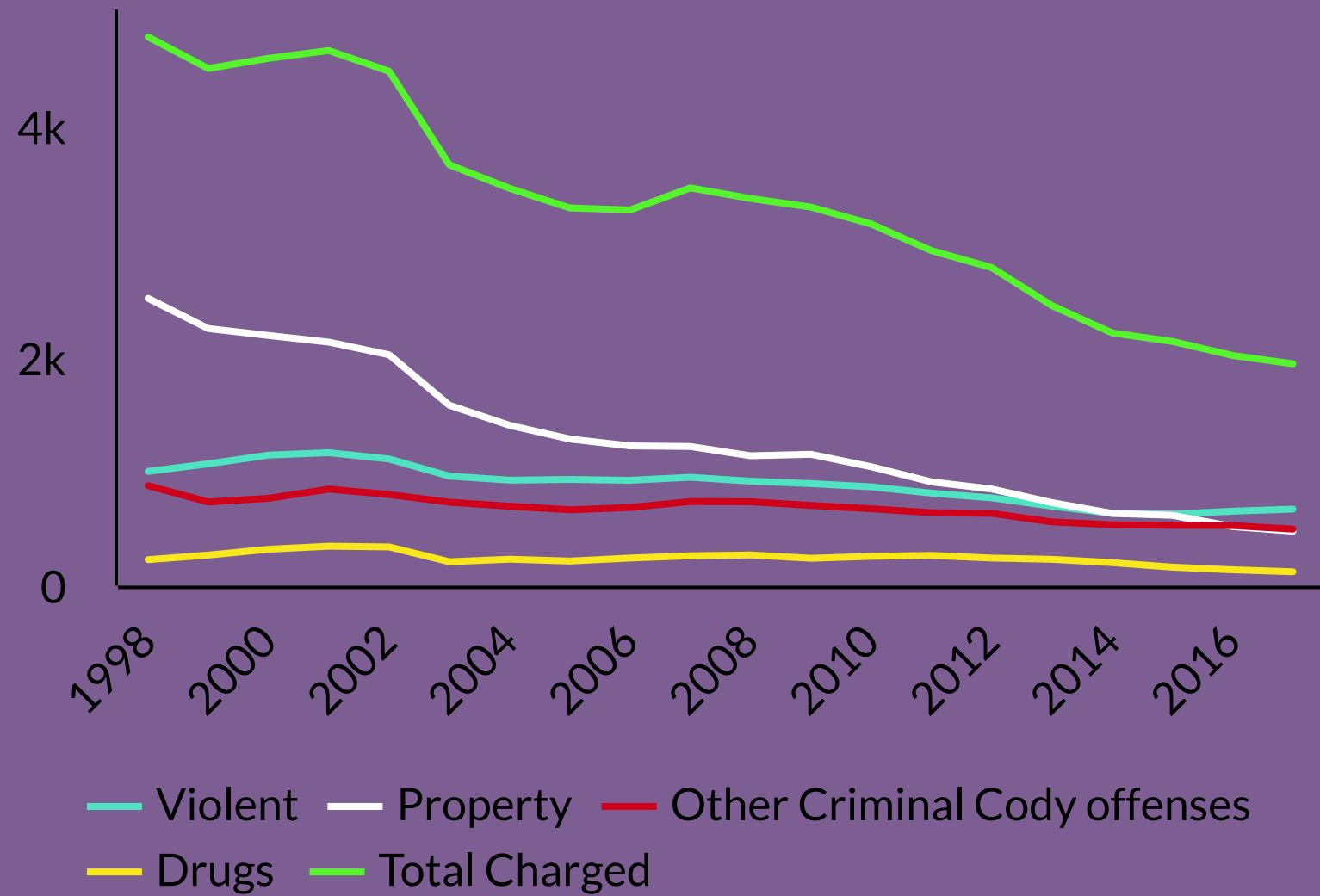
**Administration of justice cases* are

**Offences related to case proceedings, such as: failure to appear in court, failure to comply with a court order, breach of probation, etc.*

Since 1997/8 youth imprisonment rates in Canada have declined by 86%. Youth crime rates also dropped
