Standards and the Voluntary System



- All standards are voluntary upon publication
- They become mandatory if referenced in law, code of conduct, contracts
 - Approx 50% of CSA OHS standards referenced in regulation
 - Approx 40% of CSA Construction standards referenced in regulation
- Regulatory agencies decide upon the reference and whether they need more or less
- A standard might be referenced municipally
