Memorandum of Understanding 14 TASK FORCE ON STUDENT ACCOMMODATIONS AND ACADEMIC CONSIDERATIONS

The parties acknowledge that, consistent with Senate Policies 159, 166, and 167, faculty members may be expected to support student accommodations requests or academic consideration requests.

The parties agree to strike a joint task force composed of no less than five representatives of each. Either party may invite a non-voting resource person(s). The mandate of the task force will be to examine the impact of student accommodation requests and academic consideration requests on faculty workload, as well as consider if there are student support approaches that may benefit both the faculty and student experience in the accommodation process, and to make appropriate recommendations.

The task force will determine its own terms of reference and will submit a report to the Association and the Provost no later than twelve months following the convening of the Committee, unless the parties agree to extend the timeline.
