Job Description:

The Fabricator is responsible for producing high-quality plastic components and finished store display products using a variety of fabrication techniques. This hands-on role requires strong experience working with acrylic, styrene, expanded PVC (EPVC), ABS and similar materials, with an emphasis on accuracy, craftsmanship, efficiency and safe work practices

Key Responsibilities:

- Perform precision saw cutting, routing, machining, polishing and finishing of acrylic, styrene, expanded PVC (EPVC), ABS and other materials used in store display and point-of-purchase production.
- Glue, bond, heat bend, form and assemble plastic components using appropriate adhesives, solvents, fixtures and fabrication methods to achieve clean, display-quality results.
- Read and interpret drawings, dimensions, templates, specifications and production instructions, and accurately measure and verify components throughout fabrication.
- Set up and safely operate fabrication tools and equipment, with the potential to operate a MultiCam CNC routing machine for cutting and machining plastic and other applicable materials.
- Inspect finished parts and assemblies for dimensional accuracy, fit, finish and overall quality, making adjustments or corrections as required.
- Fabricate and assemble prototypes, custom builds, short-run projects and production displays according to required specifications and timelines.
- Identify material, design or fabrication issues and work collaboratively with production, design and supervisory teams to determine practical solutions.
- Minimize material waste and support efficient use of labour, equipment and production materials while maintaining high standards of workmanship.
- Maintain fabrication equipment, tools and work areas in a clean, organized and safe condition and follow all company health and safety procedures.
- Support other fabrication, assembly and production requirements as needed to meet departmental and customer deadlines.

Qualifications:

- Previous hands-on fabrication experience in the store display, point-of-purchase, signage, plastics or a related manufacturing environment.
- Demonstrated experience with saw cutting, routing, polishing, gluing/bonding and heat bending of plastics, with strong working knowledge of acrylic and familiarity with styrene, EPVC, ABS and similar materials.
- Experience operating a MultiCam CNC or similar CNC routing equipment is considered an asset; training may be provided based on experience and production needs.
- Ability to accurately use measuring tools and work from drawings, dimensions, templates and production specifications.
- Strong attention to detail, problem-solving ability and a commitment to clean finishes, dimensional accuracy and overall product quality.
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively in a fast-paced production environment while following safe equipment operation and established production procedures.
