Employ iterative design, continually gathering user feedback to enhance the system (Olmsted, 2020)



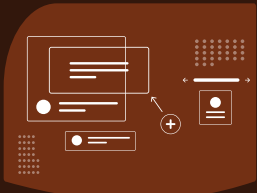
Research
