The Packaging Designer ensures that solutions have been designed to meet customer requirements. Proper thought process needs to be followed to develop solutions. Key Duties & Accountabilities (Primary responsibilities & quantifiable measurement):

- Provide quotes to the Sales team.
- Provide BOM listing for a designed solution.
- Generate assembly instructions.
- Support the Sales team by designing packaging solutions to be manufactured on-site in various materials.
- Understand the conceptual drawing or samples and create solutions using AutoCAD
 2025 and Solid Works
- Provide end to end process of scoping, designing and sampling solutions.
- Cut the samples on a digital cutter (ZUND).
- Other required tasks include ISTA testing, NCR process, quality, and inventory count.

Qualifications (What you'll need to be successful):

- Prior quoting experience is valuable.
- Creative thinker with an enthusiastic "team-player" attitude.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Strict attention to detail.
- Working knowledge of materials and processes used in package development, evaluation, and manufacturing.
- Experience in developing 2D package die-lines using current CAD software.
- Familiar with the operation of ZUND or Kongsberg cutting tables is a benefit.



- Working knowledge of Adobe Photoshop / Illustrator is a plus.
- Able to communicate effectively with internal and external stakeholders.
- Knowledge of ISTA testing is beneficial.
- Flexibility in changing priorities and responsibilities to support business needs.
- Hands-on participation and a strong sense of ownership.
- The candidate should be able to work under minimum supervision.

- This position requires good math skills to figure out the number of pieces from a sheet and the number of pieces per bag or SKID.
- To calculate multiple options for yield qty.
