

BOARD OF GOVERNORS ELECTION CONSTITUENCY AND CANDIDACY DESCRIPTIONS

ALUMNI MEMBER ELECTION

To VOTE,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • must have received one or more degree, diploma, or certificate from Toronto Metropolitan University or any of its predecessor institutions; and • must <u>not</u> be registered as a student in a program or course of study that leads to a degree, diploma, or certificate of Toronto Metropolitan University.
To NOMINATE a candidate,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • must be eligible to vote in the Alumni member election.
To be a CANDIDATE,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • must be eligible to vote in the Alumni member election at the point of nomination and during the entire voting period; • must <u>not</u> be an employee of Toronto Metropolitan University; • must submit a satisfactorily completed nomination form (available at Board Election website at https://www.torontomu.ca/governors/elections/); • must be eighteen years of age or older; • must <u>not</u> be serving as a member of any other post-secondary institution's Board of Governors or similar body; and • be approved to run as a candidate by the Election Procedures Committee.

TEACHING FACULTY MEMBER ELECTION

To VOTE,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • must be a full-time tenured or probationary teaching faculty whose principal duties include research and/or teaching functions of the University, including employees holding the Offices of Dean, Chair, Assistant Chair of department, or Academic Director, where full-time employee is defined as a regular teaching faculty member or probationer, tenure stream and is not a Limited Term Faculty or CUPE member.
To NOMINATE a candidate,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • must be eligible to vote in the Teaching Faculty member election.
To be a CANDIDATE,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • must be eligible to vote in the Teaching Faculty member election at the point of nomination and during the entire voting period; • submit a satisfactorily completed nomination form (available at Board Election website at https://www.torontomu.ca/governors/elections/); • must be eighteen years of age or older;

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● must <u>not</u> be serving as a member of any other post-secondary institution's Board of Governors or similar body; and ● be approved to run as a candidate by the Election Procedures Committee.

ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF MEMBER ELECTION

To VOTE,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● must be a full-time employee of Toronto Metropolitan University who is not a member of the teaching faculty and is serving in a regular capacity on a continuing basis where this is defined as either a full-time career employee or a term employee who has completed a minimum of 12 months of continuing employment for greater than 24 hours per week.
To NOMINATE a candidate,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● must be eligible to vote in the Administrative Staff member election.
To be a CANDIDATE,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● must be eligible to vote in the Administrative Staff member election at the point of nomination and during the entire voting period; ● must submit a satisfactorily completed nomination form (available at Board Election website at https://www.torontomu.ca/governors/elections/); ● must <u>not</u> be serving as a member of any other post-secondary institution's Board of Governors or similar body; ● must be eighteen years of age or older; and ● must be approved to run as a candidate by the Election Procedures Committee.

STUDENT MEMBER ELECTION

To VOTE,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● must be registered as a student in a program or course of study at Toronto Metropolitan University that leads to a degree, diploma, or certificate of the University.
To NOMINATE a candidate,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● must be eligible to vote in the Student member election.
To be a CANDIDATE,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● must be eligible to vote in the Student member election at the point of nomination and during the entire voting period; ● must satisfy the candidacy criteria referred to in the Election Policies and Procedures Appendix A – February 28, 2012 Election Procedure Committee Appeal Panel decision (available at Board Election website at https://www.torontomu.ca/content/dam/governors/elections/Election_Appeal_Decisions/2012_Election_Appeal_Decision.pdf) ● must submit a satisfactorily completed nomination form (available at Board Election website at https://www.torontomu.ca/governors/elections/);

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● must attend the Mandatory Student Nominees Session;● is <u>not</u> required to be eighteen years of age or older;● must <u>not</u> be serving as a member of any other post-secondary institution's Board of Governors or similar body; and● must be approved to run as a candidate by the Election Procedures Committee.
