

## ALUMNI ELECTIONS NOMINATION PROCESS

### During Nomination Period

All alumni nominations submitted to the Board Secretariat must be accompanied by a C.V.

### After Close of Nomination Period

Alumni whose nominations have been approved by the Election Procedures Committee will have their nomination forms and C.V.s forwarded to the Toronto Metropolitan University Alumni Council (TMUAC) Board of Directors for review.

The TMUAC Board of Directors review the nominees using Board-approved competencies (set out below) and provide a slate of candidates to the Returning Officer within a designated period of time, as required by the Board Secretariat.

Nominees are only permitted to campaign if the nominee has received confirmation of TMUAC's approval of their candidacy.

### BOARD APPROVED COMPETENCIES AND REQUIREMENTS

Competencies	Definition
<b><i>Management</i></b>	Experience dealing with the issues and challenges facing large, complex organizations.
<b><i>Human Resources</i></b>	Experience in human resources management, human rights, employment, labour relations and pensions.
<b><i>Financial</i></b>	Understanding of the financial considerations and issues associated with the management of large institutions. Ability to analyze financial statements.
<b><i>Legal</i></b>	Understanding of the legal considerations and issues as they relate to the various operations of a public institution.
<b><i>Governance</i></b>	Experience with governance particularly as it relates to public institutions.
<b><i>Marketing and Public Affairs</i></b>	Experience with stakeholder relations and enhancement of brand and image.
<b><i>Fundraising</i></b>	Ability to promote the University's mission and its fundraising needs and attract support for the University.
<b><i>Real Estate Development</i></b>	Experience with the real estate financing, construction, management, development and partnerships particularly in downtown urban settings.
<b><i>Arts/Cultural</i></b>	Knowledge of the arts/communications and design sector.
<b><i>Represents Diversity of RU</i></b>	Representative of the greater Toronto area's social and cultural diversity.
<b><i>Enhances Reputation</i></b>	Status or experience enhances the overall reputation of the Board and the University. Will help to provide the university with new contacts and connections.
<b><i>Demonstrated Interest in RU</i></b>	Interest or experience with the University and/or its mission.
<b><i>Research</i></b>	Interest or experience in research in the university or industry context.
<b><i>Government Relations</i></b>	Understanding of policy decision making at the municipal, provincial and federal levels. Knowledge of and ability to influence policy makers.
