Undergraduate Students

Domestic tuition fees range from \$6,110 (for Arts & Science) to \$10,189 (for Engineering). International students pay between \$33,190 and \$38,590.

Graduate Students

Domestic tuition fees for Master's range from \$4,307 (for Communication & Culture) to \$23,223 (for the MBA). International students pay between \$24,990 and \$53,660.

Domestic tuition fees for a PhD range from \$4,307 (for Communication & Culture) to \$7,612 (all other PhD programs). All International students pay \$23,940.

Costs of books and supplies range from \$700 to \$1,500.
