Tuition Costs (2025-26 Academic Year)

Undergraduate Students

Domestic tuition fees range from \$6,110 (for Arts & Science) to \$10,189 (for Engineering). International students pay between \$34,850 and \$40,520. Law School domestic tuition is \$21,168.

Graduate Students

Domestic tuition fees for Master's range from \$4,307 (for Communication & Culture) to \$24,965 (for the MBA). International students pay between \$25,740 and \$56,340.

Domestic tuition fees for a PhD range from \$4,307 (for Communication & Culture) to \$7,612 (all other PhD programs). All International students pay \$24,660. Costs of books and supplies range from \$700 to \$1,500.
