I will take extreme care of the documents provided by the host organization. None will be taken from the premises without explicit permission from a responsible person.

I will securely dispose notes and drafts, whether handwritten or typed, that may be considered confidential.

I will not save placement-related documents with identifying information as computer files on personal devices or on computers at the University.

I understand that all course-required reports will only be shared with the faculty involved in advising and evaluating the work, and with host organizations upon request.

I understand that my obligation to maintain confidentiality remains even after my field placement ends.

I understand and agree that if the conditions of this agreement are not met, or are broken at any stage of the field placement, the field placement will be terminated immediately upon discovery of the breach of the agreement.
