

Research Ethics Update

*The **Intergenerational Advisory Committee (IAC)** young people are being **recruited following an ICCRP process of informed consent**. They will be involved with the ICCRP as **advisors**.



We are advancing our protocol at Toronto Metropolitan University for the ICCRP **Child and Youth Activism Projects** in Ontario, New Brunswick, Brazil, South Africa & Scotland. Additional ethics approvals with all pertinent institutions will be pursued thereafter.



Congratulations to co-applicant **Virginia Caputo** from Carleton University on her successful ethics protocol for her case study, **"Shaking the Movers: A Model for Exploring Intergenerational Children's Rights"**. We are currently pursuing TMU's ethics review. We can't wait to start this research with you!
