Winter admission (January 2022)

- International Student Winter Merit Scholarships, valued at \$5,000 CAD each.

Fall admission (September 2022)

- President's Entrance Scholarships, valued at up to \$40,000 CAD each.
- International Secondary School Merit Scholarships, valued at \$5,000 CAD each.

Admission Requirements

ryerson.ca/international/admissions/how-to-apply/country-specific

- Admission is based on competitive grades in program specific subject requirements and competitive overall admission averages, as well as non-academic requirements where applicable.
- Graduation from Grade 12 of an academic program at an accredited secondary school with high academic standing including minimum B grades in the program-specific subject prerequisites and a minimum B overall average. In most cases, subject prerequisites should be completed at the AP level and/or Grade 12 honours/senior academic level (some exceptions apply).
- Ryerson University is test optional. While we do not have a minimum SAT or ACT score requirements, strong performance on a standardized test can strengthen an application. If SAT or ACT examinations have been written, the results should be submitted. Institutional codes are SAT/CEEB (0886) and ACT (5166).

- Advanced Placement (AP) examination results will also be considered. AP courses with examination scores of 4 or higher will be considered for transfer credit on an individual basis. Engineering students are not eligible for transfer credits for core and professional engineering courses using AP examinations.

WINTER ADMISSION (JANUARY 2022)

Selected programs will consider applications for the winter term. Applications should be submitted by October 15, 2021.

- Apply through the Ryerson University International Application.

FALL ADMISSION (SEPTEMBER 2022)

The Guaranteed Consideration Date for applications to all programs (Grades-Plus and Grades-Only) is February 1, 2022.
