

Ph.D. Supervisory Committee Approval Form

This form must be filed with the Program Office no later than the END of the first semester of registration in PhD program.

The role of the supervisory committee is to assist supervisors in providing guidance, consultation and advice on the student's research. The members' areas of expertise generally complement that of the supervisor. Specific responsibilities of the supervisory committees include:

- Meeting with the student, as a committee, as required but not less than once per year to assess the student's progress in the program and advise on future work required for completion of the degree requirements.
- Submitting a written report at least once per year to the Graduate Program Director detailing its observations on the student's progress and future work as well as assessing whether research is progressing at a satisfactory or unsatisfactory level.
- Being reasonably accessible to students when called upon for discussion of academic progress, for consultation on issues related to the research project and for general guidance.
