

How to obtain a Police Reference Check (PRC) - Vulnerable Sector Check (VSC) from Toronto Police Services (TPS)

If you are a resident of Toronto (your postal code beginning with “M”), you must request the unique agency code from the MEP office by contacting midwiferyplacements@torontomu.ca. Once you have the code, you can apply online at www.tps.to/police-checks

Students who live in other municipalities or provinces can request a PRC - VSC letter from the MEP office to provide to their local Police Services. Please contact midwiferyplacements@torontomu.ca to request a PRC-VSC letter.

PRC - VSC is a requirement and must be renewed on an annual basis and valid for the duration of each placement. Please refer to the MEP website for more information.

Process for Toronto residents:

- Request the unique agency code from midwiferyplacements@torontomu.ca and apply online at www.tps.to/police-checks.
- Applicants can still apply in-person or by mail. Please contact midwiferyplacements@torontomu.ca to request a copy of the application form.
- The fee is \$26.72
- The processing time varies. We recommend you allow 6-8 weeks for processing.
- Students are required to upload their original PRC - VSC to [Synergy Verified](#). It is the responsibility of the student to have the valid original available at all times during clinical placements.
- If the PRC - VSC is ‘Not Clear’, this does not automatically disqualify a student from entering a placement. Please contact the MEP Program Director to discuss options.
