

# Placement

## Requirements:

Entry Year to MWF 344  
Advanced Clinical Skills  
I and Fall MWF 122  
Fundamentals in  
Midwifery II

### Tips:

- Start early and plan ahead
- Requirements may not lapse
- Book Synergy verification appointment at least 1 week before a deadline or expiry
- Cluster renewals to minimize Synergy review fees
- Apply for PRC-VSC at least 1 month prior to the deadline
- Ensure all certificates meet MEP and CMO requirements
- Upload all documents to Synergy < 9 am on the day of the review appointment
- Submit the NRP certificate by email to the MEP, not Synergy

## Prior to entry to Fall MWF 122

1. Neonatal Resuscitation (valid for 1 year)
  - Canadian Paediatric Society NRP for **all** levels in accord with the College of Midwives of Ontario [Continuing Competency Requirements](#)
  - Card to include levels, course provider, instructor, NRP ID, and date of issue
  - NRP card to be submitted by email to the MEP at [midwiferyplacements@torontomu.ca](mailto:midwiferyplacements@torontomu.ca), **not** Synergy

## Annually required by Sept 7

2. Tuberculosis (valid for 1 year)
  - TB Self-Verification form verifying no change in TB status or TB exposure, **or**
  - Documented Health Care Provider assessment and 1-step TST or chest x-ray if required

## Ongoing certifications with no lapses

3. Police Reference Check-Vulnerable Sector Check (valid for 1 year)
  - PRC-VSC certificate by deadline, **or**
  - Submit the application or payment receipt and upload the PRC-VSC certificate to Synergy within 8 weeks
4. N95 Mask Fit Certification (valid for 2 years)
  - Mask fit card to include mask type/model, size, and date of issue
5. Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (valid for 2 years)
  - CPR provider and level must comply with the CMO [Continuing Competency Requirements](#)
  - CPR card to include level, course provider and instructor, certification number, and date of issue
6. Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System and Environmental Health & Safety Awareness (never expires)
  - Complete the TMU D2L WHMIS and EHS training for external placement students, **or** another Canadian certified WHMIS/HSA training program
  - Certificates must include provider and date of issue

\* The Tuberculosis Self-Verification must be submitted to Synergy Gateway before Sept 1 to be verified by the MEP by Sept 7. The NRP certificate must be submitted to the MEP prior to entry to fall MWF 122. PRC-VSC and all certifications must be renewed to remain valid with no lapses during placements until the end of the program.
