

MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR

Welcome to the third **Annual Research and Achievement Report** for the Department of Psychology at Ryerson University, highlighting contributions for the 2013-2014 academic year. The accomplishments of our faculty, postdocs, and students comprise over 55 pages of diverse contributions spanning all major areas of Psychology, as well as a number of related fields. The report includes awards, honours, grants, publications, presentations, media interviews, and various other contributions over the previous year.

Here are some highlights of the report, which includes contributions from June 2013 through May 2014:

Summary of Research Accomplishments

- More than 25 prestigious external awards and honors
- The Psychology Department's first appointment of a faculty member to the Royal Society of Canada
- A number of Canadian Psychological Association (CPA) honours awarded to our faculty members, including the *President's New Researcher Award*, the *CPA Clinical Section Scientist-Practitioner Early Career Award*, and *CPA Fellow Status*
- Two new funded research chairs awarded to faculty members in the Psychology Department.
- Several university-wide research awards received by faculty members
- 29 new external research grants, representing more than \$6.8 million in funding
- 145 peer reviewed journal publications
- 65 books and book chapters published
- 14 other publications
- 227 poster and conference presentations
- 68 external workshops, invited lectures, and colloquia

Undergraduate Program

- We received 3084 **applications for Fall 2013 admission to our BA program**. A total of 134 students were admitted, with a mean incoming average of 87.59% or higher. All incoming

students were eligible for entrance scholarships based on their grades.

- The Psychology Students' Association held a number of events over the year, including its third annual Welcome Day (August 2013) and a panel discussion called "Stigma: Let's talk about what we don't talk about" (January 2014)
- In April 2014, our **Undergraduate Honours Thesis Poster Session** was held showcasing 17 different research projects conducted by students registered in the thesis stream option of our undergraduate program.

Graduate Programs

- We received over 300 **applications for Fall 2013 admission to our MA/PhD program**. 15 new students were admitted across our Psychological Science and Clinical Psychology streams.
- Our third cohort of clinical psychology students matched for their predoctoral internships in February 2014. Despite an 84% success rate across Canada (for the first match), 100% of Ryerson University students matched with an internship placement for the third year in a row.
- Ryerson Psychology PhD graduates received three major awards conferred at the Fall 2013 convocation, including the *Governor General Gold Medal*, the *Ryerson Gold Medal*, and the *Board of Governors Student Leadership Award and Medal*.
- In October 2013, the Psychology Graduate Students' Association hosted their annual **Psychology Research Symposium**, an event celebrating the research of the

department's current graduate students. Keynote speaker, Dr. David Dozois (University of Western Ontario), gave a presentation on the role of cognition in depression, after which the event continued with several graduate student talks and a well attended poster session featuring graduate student research in the Department.

Other Highlights

- In August 2013, the Department welcomed **Dr. Becky Choma** to Ryerson University, where she is now a tenure track assistant professor and Director of the Social and Political Psychology Lab. Previously, she was a faculty member at Plymouth University in the UK. Her research focuses on the psychology of tolerance and intolerance, as well as on prejudice and discrimination. We also welcomed two limited term faculty members (**Drs. Tsasha Awong** and **Kosha Bramesfeld**) and two new postdoctoral fellows (**Drs. Nooshin Rotondi** and **Anne Wagner**) to the Department.
- Two new staff members joined the Psychology Department. **Sarah Carmichael** was appointed in August 2013 as our new Undergraduate Program Administrator, following much experience in student advising in the United Kingdom and experience as a Developmental Editor for Routledge/Taylor and Francis (in the United Kingdom) and Oxford University Press (Canada). **Jessica Sutherland** (a former graduate of our BA program) served as our Undergraduate Program Assistant, in between her masters in criminology and her doctoral studies in Psychology, which began in Fall 2014.
- Psychology offered 60 courses through the **Chang School of Continuing Education**, including our 8-course Certificate In Psychology, our 10-Course certificate in Mental Health and Addictions, and various standalone courses. In Winter 2014, we offered our first ever graduate level continuing education course (focused on clinical supervision). 3054 students enrolled in our CE courses last year.
- In August 2013, Ryerson University hosted more than 400 delegates at the biennial meeting of the *Society for Music Perception and Cognition* (SMPC). The SMPC conference also featured two satellite meetings, including the third annual meeting of *CogMIR* (focused on music Informatics) and the fifth annual meeting of *AIRS* (*Advancing Interdisciplinary Research in Singing*).
- In May 2014, we held our annual **Psychology Research and Awards Celebration** at the Arts and Letters Club of Toronto where over 55 of our undergraduate and graduate students were honoured with various internal and external awards. In addition, almost 70 Psychology students (the highest number of any department in the Faculty of Arts) were on the Dean's List, in recognition of their accomplishments during the 2013-2014 academic year.
- Psychology Department members were quoted in well over 50 media outlets, including Boston Globe, CBC News, Huffington Post, Maclean's Magazine, New York Times, Popular Science, Psychology Today, and Smithsonian Magazine Online, to name a few.

On behalf of my co-editors and the entire Department of Psychology, we hope you find this report to be informative, and we look forward to sharing next year's accomplishments in our 2014-2015 report, scheduled for publication by Fall 2015.
