MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR

The Department of Psychology at Ryerson University is delighted to share our first **Annual Research and Achievement Report**, for the 2011-2012 academic year. The accomplishments of our faculty, postdocs, and students comprise 60 pages of diverse contributions spanning all major areas of Psychology, as well as a number of related fields. The report lists awards, honours, grants, publications, presentations, media interviews, and various other contributions from June 2011 through May 2012.

Here are some highlights from the previous academic year:

Summary of Research Accomplishments

- 159 peer reviewed journal publications
- 42 books and book chapters published
- 239 poster and conference presentations
- 74 workshops, invited lectures, and colloquia
- 11 other publications

Undergraduate Program

- We received 3331 **applications for Fall 2011 admission to our BA program** (applications were cut off at that point, or we would have received more). 130 students were admitted.
- In August 2011, the Psychology Students' Association held **Psychology Day**, a welcome day for incoming first year psychology students to meet one another and upper year students.
- In April 2012, our **Undergraduate Honours Thesis Poster Session** was held showcasing 19 different research projects conducted by students registered in the thesis stream option of our undergraduate program.

Graduate Programs

- We received 248 **applications for Fall 2011 admission to our MA/PhD program**. 18 new students were admitted.
- In October 2011, the Psychology Graduate Students' Association hosted the **Psychology Research Symposium**, an event celebrating the research of the department's current graduate students. Dr. Steve Joordens, University of Toronto, opened the event with his keynote address, Educational Technologies in Even Very Large Classes: A 1700 Student Case Study, which was followed by talks featuring several of the department's graduate students. The event concluded with a poster session, featuring dozens of posters describing graduate student research.

Graduate Programs continued...

- In May 2012, we completed our first year of operation for our **Clinical Psychology Training Clinic**, launched through a partnership between the Department of Family and Community Medicine at St Michael's Hospital and Ryerson University. The clinic is located steps from Ryerson (at 80 Bond Street), and reflects an innovative interprofessional model of care and education that draws upon a number of disciplines (medicine, nursing, nutrition, social work, chiropractic, dental). It provides our clinical psychology students with a unique opportunity to gain experience in evidence-based assessment and intervention with a wide range of clients from diverse backgrounds.

Other Highlights

- Psychology offered 58 courses through the **Chang School of Continuing Education**, including our 8-course Certificate in Psychology, our 10-Course certificate in Mental Health and Addictions, and 6-course Interprofessional Certificate in Advanced Neuroscience and Stroke Care (as well as various standalone courses). 2760 students enrolled in our CE courses last year.
- In August 2011, the Department welcomed **four new faculty members**: Drs. Alba Agostino (Research Area: Development of mathematical skills in children), Stephanie Cassin (Research Area: Eating disorders, obesity, and readiness for change), Alexandra Fiocco (Research Area: Brain health and well being in older adults), and Brad Meisner (Research Area: Successful aging in adults).
- In May 2012, we held our annual **Psychology Research and Awards Celebration** was held at the Arts and Letters Club of Toronto where nearly 100 of our undergraduate and graduate students were honoured with various internal and external awards.
- Psychology faculty received 12 Ryerson awards for teaching, research, and service – more than any other Department in the University.
- Psychology Department members were quoted in various media outlets, including CBC, CBS News, CNN, CTV News, Fox28, Globe and Mail, Huffington Post, Macleans Magazine, National Geographic Channel, USA Today, US News and World Report, Washington Post, and Yahoo! News, to name a few.

On behalf of my co-editors and the entire Department of Psychology, we hope you find this report to be informative, and we look forward to sharing the current year's accomplishments in our next report, scheduled for publication in Summer 2013!
