Honours Bachelor Degree (BA, BSc, etc) with a minimum average of B+ (78%, or equivalent of 9 GPA on 12 point scale. International experience and globalization-related background are considered assets.

- Academic Transcripts
- Two academic Reference letters
- Statement of interest
- Writing Sample
- English Language Proficiency Exam scores (for non-native English Speakers)

Program Requirements

- 12-month program
- Six 3-unit (single semester) courses
- MRP completed over the summer

- Flexibility of course selection: students may take some of their courses from other Humanities and Social Sciences disciplines, should they wish to move on to a discipline-specific PhD
