

Bill 7 Award 2SLGBTQ+ Scholarship

What is the Bill 7 Award?

The Bill 7 Award is a charitable trust that awards scholarships to gay, lesbian, bisexual, trans, queer and two-spirit post-secondary students who are studying in Ontario.

The Bill 7 Award scholarship is named after the 1986 legislation that extended the protection of the Ontario Human Rights Code to prohibit discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation.

Who Can Apply?

Any student who identifies as gay, lesbian, bisexual, trans, queer and two-spirit, who demonstrates a financial need and who is attending or accepted by a post-secondary educational institution in Ontario to pursue their first post-secondary program of study.

Scholarship Details

In 2024, the Bill 7 Award Trust will be awarding 17 or more scholarships of \$4,000 each.

Application Deadline: August 2, 2024
