- What opportunities does the research create for bringing Indigenous knowledges, critical race, feminist, queer, Mad Positive, and other perspectives to work in the profession, field work, community engagement, and curricula of relevant departments/schools?
- How will the research involve diverse communities and benefit those communities? How will this research impact disadvantaged groups?
- How will it help contribute to the access to post-secondary education and success of students from disadvantaged groups?
- What potential contribution to EDI-related scholarship will the research area entail?
