Alex Ferworn is a Professor of Computer Science. He earned his PhD from the U of Waterloo, his MSc from the U of Guelph and his B. Tech from Ryerson. He serves as the Graduate Program Director (GPD) for the Creative School's interdisciplinary Master of Digital Media (MDM) program as well as serving as the GPD for the graduate programs in Computer Science in the Department of Computer Science where he also serves as Associate Chair.

He is an incoming member of the RFA Executive. He has had significant involvement in the creation of over 30 Certificate and other programs in the Chang School where he serves as the Faculty Liaison for Science. His previous experience is varied and include; Director of Professional Graduate Diploma programs in YSGS, various roles in telecommunication companies, service as a police auxiliary and as an infantry Company Commander in the Canadian Forces Reserve. His research focuses on "Computational Public Safety" applied to the work of emergency first responders in search and rescue and Chemical Biological, Radiological and Nuclear Explosives (CBRNE) roles. In 2019 his work in creating algorithms for finding lost and wandering people living with dementia was featured at the Toronto CRAM Festival.
