1. Successful applicants will receive transfer credit for SWP 36A/B Field Practicum at the time of admission. Second Year Entry students are required to take additional courses from first year as part of their degree requirements. The following curriculum order is for your reference.
2. Please also note that the mandatory social work classes must be completed in the order that they are offered due to the prerequisite structure of the curriculum **(i.e. before you can take any courses offered in the Winter you must complete the courses offered in the Fall)**.
3. Please be aware of restrictions that exist for Social Work from Lower Level Liberal – Table A. **Social Work students cannot receive credit for courses starting with PSY, SOC or POL.
