Note:

1. It will take part-time students **a minimum of 3 academic years** to complete the program. The core social work courses, including field placements, will be offered sequentially each September/January (block placements are available for Spring/Summer). Students will complete the required elective courses at their own pace and schedule.
2. Please be aware of restrictions that exist for Social Work from Lower Level Liberal – Table A. **Social Work students cannot receive credit for courses starting with PSY, SOC or POL.
