

STUDIES AT ANOTHER INSTITUTION

If you are enrolled concurrently at Ryerson University and another post-secondary institution, your tuition, compulsory fees and books for the courses at your other institution may be added to your OSAP assessment at Ryerson if:

- They are part of your degree, diploma or certificate at Ryerson
- The courses have been designated as OSAP-eligible
- All combined courses constitute no less than 60% course-load (40% for students with a permanent disability)
- Letter of Permission from Ryerson's Curriculum Advising Department is attached (*must be attached to be considered for courses at another institution*)

You will be required to provide proof of registration for these courses (e.g. Proof of Payment for the courses, and a letter from the other institution confirming your registration) before you can obtain your OSAP loan document from Ryerson University's **Student Financial Assistance Office**.
