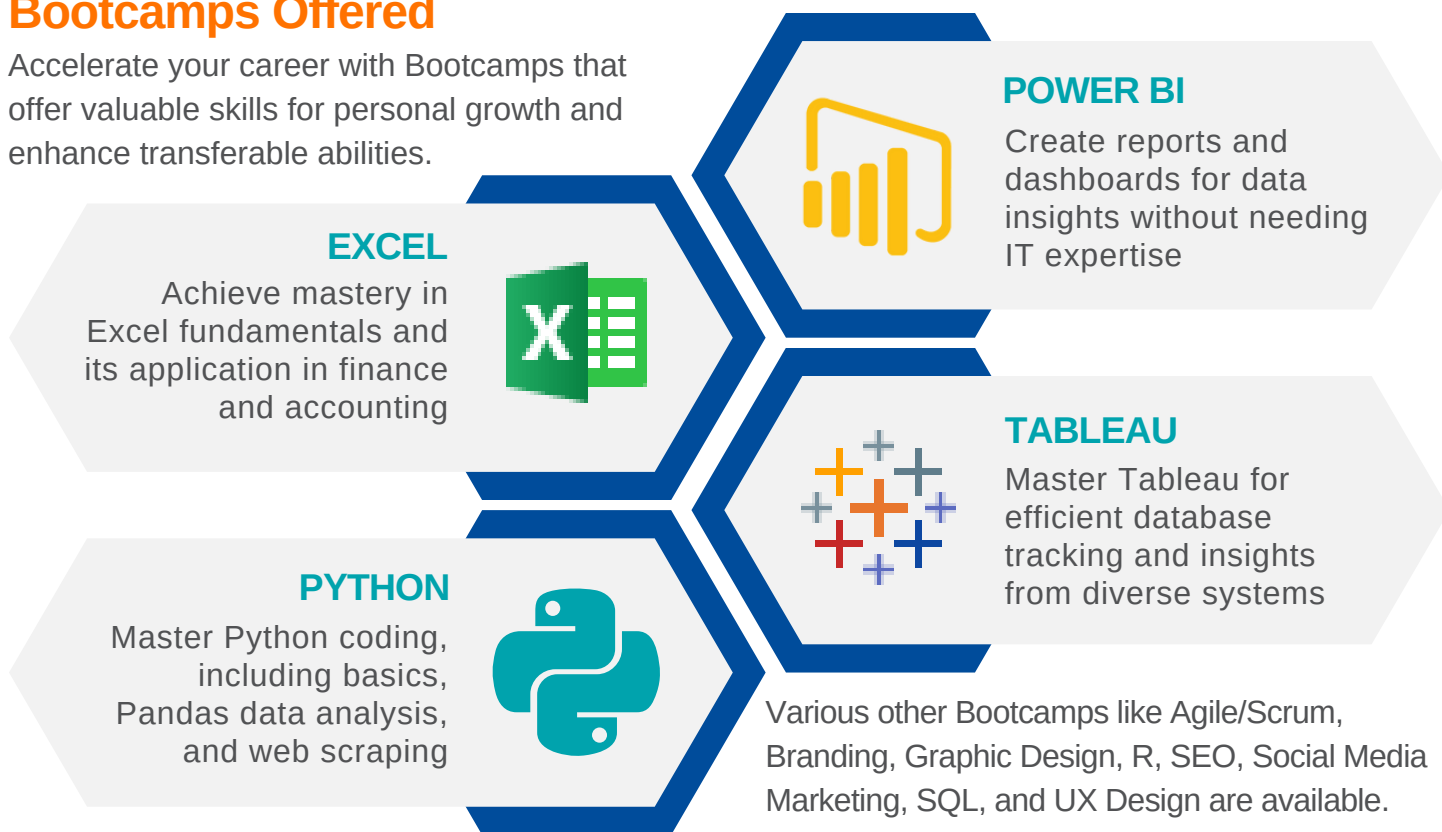

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cleaning and organizing customer data using Pandas for targeted marketing analysis.• Performing data aggregation with Pandas to identify trends and patterns in all types of data.• Implementing machine learning models with scikit-learn to predict customer behaviour.• Automating data processing tasks using scripts and libraries like Pandas and NumPy.• Creating interactive data visualizations using matplotlib to present insights effectively.
 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Creating interactive dashboards to visualize sales performance across different regions.• Using data modeling capabilities to aggregate and transform raw sales data for analysis.• Developing reports to analyze customer engagement metrics and trends for adaptability.• Integrating data from multiple sources (e.g., Excel, Social Media) for comprehensiveness.• Setting up automated data refresh schedules to ensure reflection of real-time information.• Optimizing dashboard performance and scalability to handle large datasets efficiently.• Implementing interactive filters and parameters for dynamic data exploration and insights.• Creating custom calculations/expressions for actionable insights from complex data.• Crafting compelling data stories to effectively communicate insights to stakeholders.• Optimizing dashboards for mobile devices to ensure accessibility and usability on the go.

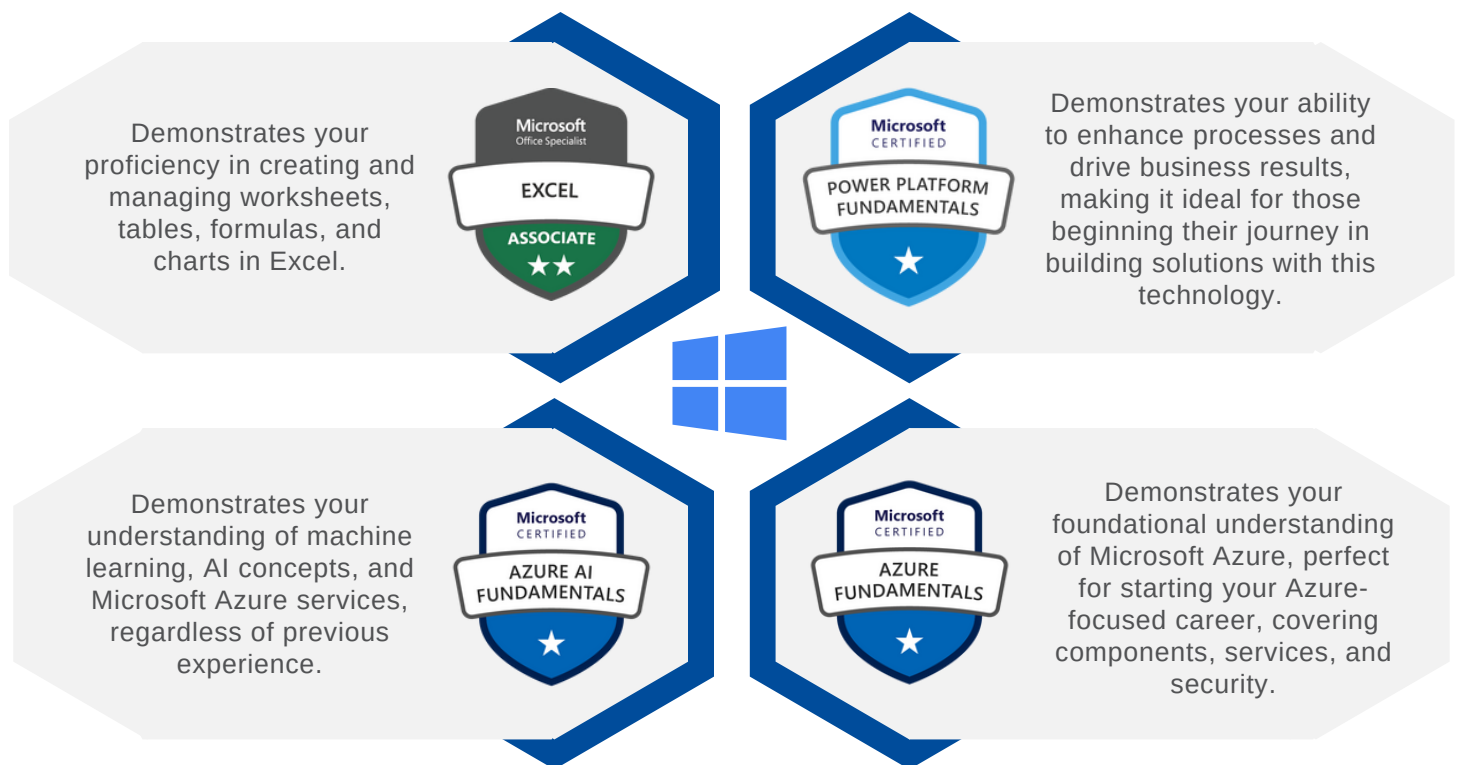
Next Step after Bootcamps: Certifications
