Ted Rogers MBA Program Ranks #3 in Canada by Bloomberg Businessweek

The Bloomberg Businessweek Best Business Schools 2022-2023 ranking is based on 18,504 surveys from students, alumni and employers, as well as compensation and employment data from each school.

Aside from its overall third place ranking in Canada, the Ted Rogers MBA program ranked #3 in Canada for compensation for students after graduation, #3 for learning and #5 for entrepreneurship.

Business Career Hub partners with Microsoft Canada and CIBC

The Business Career Hub is running a specialized 10-week program, in partnership with Microsoft Canada and CIBC, called "Digital Financial Skills Accelerator". Over 100 Ted Rogers undergraduate students are placed in one of three streams, 1) Cloud/Data/Artificial Intelligence, 2) User Experience and Accessibility and 3) Cybersecurity.

Throughout this program, students earn Microsoft certifications, attend industry-hosted events and work with their peers to solve a case study, leveraging the knowledge they have gained.
