### Can You See Yourself as a Consultant?

Although Covid-19 has had a negative impact on some businesses, many industry sectors are expected to grow significantly over the next few years including Consulting. This report highlights some cool facts in the Management, IT and HR consulting fields.<sup>1</sup>

### So What Does A Consultant Do?

Utilizing an extensive network of industry experts, as well as specialists in certain fields, the daily work of a Consultant includes gathering data and insights, analyzing data, and making presentations.

### What is a Typical Career Path for a Consultant?

There are two major tracks: 1) the traditional consulting track and 2) the supporting track.<sup>5</sup>



A traditional consulting firm has 4-5 levels:

1. Intern
2. Junior Consultant/Analyst
3. Senior Consultant/Associate
4. Project Manager/Project Leader
5. Partner/Director


A supporting track consists of two roles:

1. **Experienced Consultant:** Former Consultant and assists Junior Consultants to master the expertise in their projects.
2. **Newly Hired Expert:** An expert in a specific industry that does not have experience in consulting, for example: an expert in farming.

## Lets Talk About The Money!


A Junior Consultant's salary varies from firm to firm, the maximum annual salary will be about \$98,000 with a base of \$85,000.<sup>6</sup>

Although not true for all Consultants, according to a report authored by a former Consultant from Accenture, the life of a Consultant may involve 14-hour days.<sup>7</sup>

- ✓ How do you manage your **emotions**? Do you lose your temper or get frustrated easily with others?<sup>8</sup>


