Of these, 7,500 (or 85.3%) had a CLEAR standing at the end of the 2022/23 academic year.
3. Zero values are shown as blanks. Blank cells are the result of cohorts with a very small number of students. Cells with "n/a" indicate faculties/programs that were either discontinued or had yet to begin.
4. The increase in the percentage clear after 1 year for the 2019-20 cohort is largely due to the change in academic standing policy during the COVID-19 pandemic.
