Featured Story: Seminar on Migration in China, June 13, 2007



A seminar on Migrants' Social Network Used in Seeking Employment in Urban Areas of China was held June 13 at the Ted Rogers School of Management. The seminar was delivered by Professor Zhang Jijiao, a visiting researcher from the Institute of Ethnology and Anthropology at the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences.

The seminar was jointly sponsored by the International Research Institute and the Diversity Institute in Management and Technology at Ted Rogers School of Management. Over a dozen scholars from

different departments of Ryerson University including the Gateway Program for International Educated Professionals at the Chang School of Continuing Education and the Joint Centre of Excellence for Research on Immigration and Settlement took part in the seminar and had enthusiastic discussions on migration issues in China and similar challenges in Canada, such as immigrant adaptation and social policies.

Professor Zhang also gave a brief introduction on ethnic & migration research in China and on the International Congress of Anthropological & Ethnic Studies to be held in China in 2008.

— Faculty Spotlight: Nina Cole —

Dr. Nina Cole has spent the last three months as a visiting professor at Victoria University in Melbourne Australia, collecting data for four research studies on expatriate management: how to enhance spousal adjustment; reasons for better work and interaction adjustment by female expatriates; personality characteristics associated with effective expatriate coping techniques; and demographic characteristics associated with expatriate adjustment. Participating multinationals include Cisco Systems, IBM, and Air International Thermal Systems. Other expatriate participants have been obtained through pres-



entations to the Australian Human Resources Institute (inset photo) and the Victoria University Faculty of Business and Law; contacts made through the Newcomers' Network in Melbourne; and colleagues at Monash University, Deakin University and the University of Melbourne. Nina is now moving on to collect data in Singapore, Malaysia, Cambodia, the Philippines, and Hong Kong during the fall, and then in China during the first half of 2008.
